- Updated Installation Wizard.

Version 2.1

- Ability to pre-configure settings file before client installations/deployments
- Ability to label application to organisation brand name
- Removal of Advanced Settings from Interface
- Ability to export foreign characters
- Auto-Login to Campaigner once list exported now possible
- Log files feature added
- InterAction Menu Item Export Feature Added
- Ability to choose whether start menu items, InterAction Menu Item and/or Log Files are to be installed.

Version 2.2

- Settings File Location Choice Added to Installation Wizard
- Log Files Location Choice Added to Installation Wizard
- Uninstall Clean-Up
- Citrix Compatibility Confirmed.

Version 2.2.1

• Fixed bug with obtaining network credentials for authenticating through proxy. Bug only affected clients with "UseIEProxySettings" enabled.

Version 2.2.2

 Added support for Local and system variables (e.g. %APPDATA%) when specifying storage location of the settings file. This should allow more flexibility for installation on mixed environments.

Added compatibility with 64-bit environments

 Added compatibility to new version of Concep Campaigner. The settings file indicates which EMS the contacts should be exported to.
